3. Purpose: The Town Board of the Town of Burke, County of Franklin hereby finds and declares that the purpose of this local law is to provide for the licensing and identification of dogs. 4. All terms not specifically defined herein shall have the meaning assigned to such terms within § 108 of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York. As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated: AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW: The Agriculture and Markets Law of a. the State of New York in effect as of the effective date of this Chapter, as amended by this Chapter, and as thereafter amended. IDENTIFICATION TAG - a tag issued by the Town Clerk which sets forth the b. identification number together with the name of the Town and State, the telephone number of the Town Clerk, and any other information deemed necessary by the Town Clerk. c. OWNER – means any person who harbors or keeps any dog or other animal.

OWNER OF RECORD - means the person in whose name a dog was last

  - otherwise exempted, shall be licensed. No license shall be required for any dog which is under the age of four months and which is not at large. The owner of each dog required to be licensed shall obtain, complete and return c. to the Town Clerk of the Town a dog license application together with the license application fee, any applicable license surcharges and such additional fees as may

•	a. The Town does not allow the licensing of dogs by a shelter. The shelter MUST send the adoptive dog owners to the Town Clerk of the Town in which the dog will be harbored for licensing OR to the Town Clerk of the Town, where the Shelter is located for the purchase of the license for adoption purposes.
7.	Proof of Vaccination against Rabies Each license application shall be accompanied by proof that the dog has been vaccinated against rabies or a statement from a licensed veterinarian that such vaccination would endanger the dog's life in which case vaccination shall not be required.
8.	Term of License and Renewals  a. Option 1  i. Each license issued pursuant to this local law, shall be valid for a period of one year and shall expire on the last day of the last month of the period for which it was issued. No license shall be issued for a period expiring after the last day of the eleventh month following the expiration date of the current rabies certificate for the dog being licensed.
9.	Fees: Fees shall be established by the Town Board from time to time.
10.	<ul> <li>Issuance of license; identification tag.</li> <li>a. Upon validation by the Town Clerk of the Town, a dog license shall be issued and a record of its issuance retained in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town. Such record shall be made available upon request to the State Commissioner of Agriculture and Markets, or successor thereof.</li> </ul>
	b. No license shall be transferable. Upon the transfer of ownership of any dog, the new owner shall immediately apply for a new license for the dog. A license cannot be transferred to another dog.
	<ul> <li>c. Change of Ownership, Lost or Stolen Dogs</li> <li>i. Upon the transfer of ownership of any dog, the new owner shall immediately make application for a license for such dog. The original issued identification tag shall remain the same for the life of the dog.</li> <li>ii. In the event of a change in ownership of any dog which has been assigned an official identification number or in the event of a change of address of</li> </ul>

- the owner of record of any such dog, the owner of record shall, within ten days of such change, notify the Town Clerk. iii. If any dog which has been assigned an official identification number is lost or stolen, the owner of record shall, within ten days of the discovery of such loss or theft, notify the Town Clerk. In the case of a dog's death, the owner of record shall so notify the Town iv.
- Clerk either prior to renewal of license or upon the time of such renewal. Identification tag. d. i. The Town Clerk shall assign a Town permanent official identification

number to a dog when it is first licensed. Such identification number shall be carried by the dog on an identification tag which shall be affixed to the

	<ul> <li>collar of the dog at all times.</li> <li>ii. An identification tag is not required to be worn while the dog is participating in a dog show.</li> <li>iii. The official permanent identification number shall constitute the official identification of the dog to which it is assigned, regardless of changes of ownership, and the number shall not be reassigned to any other dog during the lifetime of the dog to which it is assigned.</li> <li>iv. No tag carrying an identification number shall be affixed to the collar of any dog other than the one to which the number has been assigned</li> </ul>
11.	Purebred Dog License and Fee  a. There will not be distinct purebred licenses as previously provided for by the State. Any and all existing purebred licenses will now be required to comply with this local law.
12.	Penalties  a. Any person convicted of a violation of this Local Law shall be liable for a civil penalty of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for a first violation; of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for a second violation and Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) for each subsequent violation.
13.	Repeal of Inconsistent Local Laws or Ordinances:  a. This Local Law shall supersede all prior inconsistent Local Laws, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations relative to the licensing of dogs within the Town. All prior inconsistent Local Laws, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations shall be, upon the effectiveness of this Local Law, null and void.
14.	Severability Clause  a. The provision of this local law are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or part thereof is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or part of this ordinance
15.	Effective Date  a. This local law shall be effective January 1, 2011 after filing with the Secretary of State.
